Welcome to the Summer Season 2015 at the Redwood City Elk's Lodge Pool Complex! We had a very successful 2014 and we are looking forward to a great season for 2015! Most of the staff from 2014 will be returning along with a couple of new faces and they are looking forward to seeing the Members and their guests back up at the Pool Complex this summer. Spring Pre-Season Pool Hours for Members ONLY: The pool will be heated during May for Members only (key card holders) to workout, lane swim, etc. There can be NO guests brought to the pool complex including your children or grandchildren prior to the opening of the Pool Complex on Saturday, May 23, 2015 at 11:00 a.m. when the pool will be open to guests of Members via day use fees or seasonal pool passes. Please remember that swimming alone is extremely dangerous and you should plan to swim with a buddy or alert family members that you are at the pool swimming. Lodge #1991 assumes no liability for your use of the pool while it is not staffed with lifeguards

Some other important information: A Lodge representative will be available on Saturday, May 23, 2015 from 11:00 a.m.- 5 p.m at the Lodge Office to issue season passes for those who did not have a chance to request them **via mail**. If you arrive after 5 p.m., you can leave your completed request form along with appropriate fees and you will received a wristband (for your family members you are purchasing Pool Passes) for that day. The Secretary's Office handles all season pool pass purchases. Generally, a Lodge employee will be available from 9 a.m.-2 p.m. weekdays if you want to come in person. If you cannot make this time frame, please plan to mail in your request.

Summer Season 2015 Calendar:

- Opening Day is Saturday, May 23, 2014 at 11:00 a.m.
- The facility will be open weekends ONLY:
May 23, 24 and 25 , May 30 and May 31, and June 6 and 7.
- Operating hours on those weekends will be Saturdays and Sundays , 11 a.m. – 7 p.m. and a limited Snack Shack menu will be available during the weekend only operations
- Our daily schedule will be begin June 13, 2015. Hours will Monday - Friday 11 a.m. – 6 p.m. and Saturday and Sunday 11 a.m. – 7 p.m. Due to weather or low attendance, staff may close the Pool Complex early. Please DO NOT enter the Pool Complex if you have not signed off on an after hours waiver. As has been the case at the end of August/early September, our staff begins returning to school. We will provide information on schedule changes that will inevitably occur due to staff availability as the season draws to a close.

The Pool Complex Staff looks forward to seeing you, your family members and your guests on the deck this summer!

Lodge #1991 Pool Complex Fees for the Summer Season 2015

Seasonal Pool Pass Fees:** All members in good standing may purchase seasonal pool use passes for their spouse/partner and their children/grandchildren between the ages of 5-20. A maximum of 4 passes will be charged to any one member.

-**Active Member of Lodge #1991:** NO CHARGE

-**Member's Spouse/Partner:** \$75.00 per person

-**Member's Children/Grandchildren** (all children and young adults between the ages of 5-20): \$75.00 per person.

(Member's children/grandchildren who are 21 years of age or older must pay Non-Member Guest day use fees and be accompanied by an Active Member of the Lodge. At the age of 21, the individual can apply to become a member of Lodge #1991 and have full membership privileges.)

Day Use Fees:** These fees apply to anyone who does not have a seasonal pool pass or does not qualify for a seasonal pool pass. For Active Members of #1991 who choose not to purchase Seasonal Pool Passes for their qualifying family members, Day Use fees will apply to your family members at the time of each visit.

Active Member: No Fee

Member's Spouse/Partner: \$8.00 daily

Member's Child/Grandchild: \$8.00 (any child or young adult between the ages of 5-20)

Non-Member Guests* Ages 5-65: \$10.00

Visiting Elk or Senior: \$8.00 (Senior is defined as 65+ years or older)

**Non-member guests must be accompanied by a member or member's spouse/partner.*

***Day Use Fees are non-refundable for pool closures beyond the control of staff.*

Grandchildren: for members with grandchildren between the ages of 5- 20.

Members with grandchildren may purchase pool passes for up to 4 grandchildren between the ages of 5-20. Seasonal pool pass fees will be charged according the schedule above. All other family members will be charged the daily fees for non-member guests. Day Use fees apply prior to the purchase of a seasonal pool pass and are non-refundable and cannot be applied to the future purchase of a seasonal pass for your grandchildren.

Lodge #1991 Pool Safety and Sanitation Rules: (2015)

General Safety Rules:

- Personal conduct within the pool facility must be such that the safety of self and others is not jeopardized. No running or boisterous play.
- When present, lifeguards are responsible for enforcing all rules.
- The outdoor shower provided should be used prior to entering the pool.
- Absolutely NO FOOD or DRINKS are allowed in the swimming pool. Bottled water okay.
- Chewing gum, sticky candy and popcorn are not permitted anywhere in the pool complex.
- All beverage containers must be plastic or aluminum, no glass containers are allowed.
- No diving is allowed in the pool in shallow end.
- Noodles and kickboards are allowed in the pool.
- Inflated beach balls will be permitted at the discretion of lifeguard staff.
- Baby floatation rings are permitted up to the following dimensions: 21”(w) X 27”(l)
- Balls, including Nerf or water type balls, large flotation rings, floating lounges, inflated boats, and rafts are NOT permitted in the pool.
- Any floatation device used by infants, toddlers, non-swimmers or weak swimmers must be Coast Guard approved. Water wings are not permitted.
- All furniture on the pool deck shall remain a minimum of 4 feet from the edge of the pool to ensure safe walking space around the swimming pool for staff.
- Animals are prohibited from the entire swimming pool complex.
- All children 3 years of age and younger OR who are NOT toilet-trained shall wear swim diapers at all times. No cloth or regular diapers are allowed in the pool. **(SEE NOTE BELOW ON SWIM PANTS)**

•Valuables should remain at home and personal effects should be supervised. LODGE 1991 ASSUMES NO LIABILITY FOR THE LOSS OR THEFT OF PERSONAL BELONGINGS BROUGHT TO THE POOL COMPLEX.

- Any adult or child who is experiencing even a mild case of diarrhea or vomiting or has within the previous 5 days is not to enter the swimming pool water.
- Pool water is not suitable for drinking. Avoid swallowing pool water.
- Spitting, spouting of water, blowing the nose or otherwise introducing contaminants into the pool water is not permitted.
- Food should be consumed at picnic tables. Litter and food waste is to be disposed of in containers marked for trash. Please recycle all beverage containers in the bins marked for recycling.
- Entry into the swimming pool water is prohibited for the following: any infectious conditions such as colds, fever, ringworm, foot infections, inflamed eyes, ear discharges or any other condition that has the appearance of being infectious. Further, anyone with open wounds or bandages shall not enter the swimming pool water.

Swim Diapers: For young swimmers, who are not toilet trained or prone to accidents, please use a product such as Little Swimmers. Additionally, we will require that a swim pant be placed over the disposable swim diaper product. If you are unfamiliar with swim pants, please see staff at the Snack Shack. If necessary, the staff can provide you with approved swim pants at a minimum charge.
